Almost a year ago, the apartment we used to live in caught fire because of some electrical issues in the building, and to make things better, this happened on Thanksgiving day. In the same year, my dad had surgery because they discovered that he has Crohn's Disease. These events and having my two brothers serving their missions made it difficult for my family to have enough money to send me on a mission as well. The assistance the Foundation gave me helped alleviate some of that financial stress.

My daughter is the oldest of 9 children, and as the oldest, she helps mom take the kids to school at least two times a week. She also helps clean the house, takes them to church, and helps them with their homework. She has even helped me pay the utilities and sometimes the mortgage since I was not working and couldn't afford to. **During this time, I was unable to save for her mission.** Our income is limited, and we almost lost our home recently. However, **with prayers and faith, everything has worked out ever since she decided she wanted to serve the Lord.** As you can expect, the Foundation's help has been a huge blessing to my daughter and our family.

My father spent almost 30 days in the hospital at the beginning of March for Covid-19 treatment. He spent 15 days on a ventilator, and a miracle happened where he was able to recover and return home. Since we do not have health insurance, our medical and hospital bills are enormous. I am Diabetic, and I too have high medication costs every month. My stake president thought that I wouldn't be able to serve my mission because of the pandemic and because I am classified as a person of high risk. **But another miracle** happened, my calling went through, and I received financial help. I am incredibly grateful!
