We have most things taken care of but the one thing I'm worried about is finding the money to buy a bicycle for my mission.



I'm not a member of the Church but I've heard about this amazing foundation that helps missionaries in their difficult times. I'm referring a friend who worked for our family as a nanny and I know her family is going through a tough time. I'm sure this could help.



As service missionaries we've had the opportunity to assist this young man prepare for his mission. They have a family of six and they struggle to make ends meet. The family is very excited for their son to serve a mission, but are finding it difficult to have the necessary financial means to help purchase his mission items.



We are originally from Brazil. I grew up in the Church and have always wanted to serve, and now the time has finally come! My dad works full time in a grocery store, and my mom had a gallstone surgery not long ago and is slowly getting to work. What my dad gets paid is enough just for us to survive and buy things like food and pay rent, any outside expenses could not be afforded. This would be a big big help!



I am an international student from Guatemala looking for a little help. I am struggling to afford food and everyday items, and also having trouble paying tuition. With my job as a custodian, I pay normally for rent. I would really appreciate this help mostly for my studies since it is the most important part for me and my future.



I don't have enough financial support to purchase myself a laptop. The laptop would help me a lot in my online education because my phone is inconvenient and hard to use. I am a person with disability so even though I want to a part time job, my body can't do it.
